**Essential Knowledge – Geography**

Climate zones share long-term weather patterns. To interpret and construct climate graphs. Biomes are areas of the world that, because of their similar climates, have similar landscapes, animals, and plants. Global warming happens naturally as a result of the greenhouse effect. The enhanced greenhouse effect – and unnatural global warming – is caused by too many greenhouse gasses in the atmosphere. Global warming relates to an increase in Earth’s temperature only; it causes climate change, which relates to a broader set of changes. Vulnerable biomes are areas sensitive to change and most at risk of damage due to climate change.
