Homo sapiens have lived on Earth for a relatively short time; they shared the Earth with Neanderthals but not with dinosaurs. Prehistory refers to the study of humans before there was writing. Prehistoric Britain is split into the Stone Age (Palaeolithic, Mesolithic, Neolithic), Bronze Age and Iron Age. Hunter-gatherers are people who travel looking for animals to hunt and plants and berries to gather. Agriculture is the farming of plants (arable) and animals (pastoral) to eat.
