Essential Knowledge – History
Homo Sapiens first lived in Africa in 200,000 BC and migrated across the world over thousands of years. The oral tradition is the sharing of knowledge, beliefs and cultures accumulated over many generations through the spoken word. Ancient and early civilisations had many similarities with each other. The heliocentric model replaced the mainstream geocentric model. Europeans believed that their knowledge was superior to the traditional knowledge of indigenous people. They imposed western knowledge and exploited traditional knowledge.
