An empire is a group of countries ruled by one person. Ancient Egyptians believed that the pharaoh was half man, half god. They believed in an afterlife called the Field of Reeds. The Ancient Egyptians mummified bodies to preserve them for the afterlife. Egyptians used hieroglyphics to share stories with future generations.
