

PE: Badminton and Dance

RE: How do people contribute to society?

History: Early Islamic Empire
Year 4 will learn about the founding of the Early Islamic Empire. They will learn about the establishment of Baghdad and the contributions Islamic scholars in the House of Wisdom made to science, maths, medicine and technology.

Computing: Data Logging.
Year 4 will consider how and why data is collected over time. Learners will pose investigative questions, collect data and use a computer to review and analyse data.

PSHE: Keeping Safe & Healthy Living
Year 4 will look at how to keep themselves safe and healthy, including cycle safety.

Science: Physics - Sound
Year 4 will look at the relationship between strength of vibrations and volume of sound. Pupils will learn about the different parts of the ear and the role of the ear drum in passing vibrations from the air to the bones within the ear, and how these vibrations are then transmitted to the brain which interprets them.
