Noremarsh Sponsored Fun Run – Friday 3rd October 2025 and PTA Colour Run

On Friday 3rd October 2025, we will be holding our annual sponsored ‘Fun Run’ for the children of Noremarsh School.

The emphasis of this event is to combine fun with the development of a healthy body and a sharp mind. Participation is the main objective and children can walk, hop, skip, etc. the course and do not have to run if they choose not to. We believe all the children taking part in this amazing event will have a great sense of achievement at the end of this race. As usual, we intend to include Noremarsh Park as part of the course.

The course will take roughly 10 - 15 minutes. **It will be a PE UNIFORM Day** so please send your child to school in appropriate Noremarsh sportswear with trainers/daps ready for the run. If your child is asthmatic, please remember that they need to have their inhaler with them in a pocket.

Please find attached a sponsor form for you to fill in and bring back to school with any monies raised by Friday 10th October. All monies raised from this event will go directly to the school and will help towards the purchase of playground equipment.

After the event, the children will be invited to take part in the PTA hosted colour run.
