Re: Year 5 - Our World

As you may know we have run a successful Our World programme over the last few years at Royal Wootton Bassett Academy and we're happy to be running a similar event in 2026. Next year's programme will aim to teach pupils about "Our World" through a variety of subjects, whilst building confidence about coming to RWBA. All of the sessions will be held here at the Academy, free of charge and we'd like to invite your son/daughter to join us.

One other important aim of this programme is to reassure any worries or concerns pupils may have about joining RWBA in the future. The aim is to familiarise pupils with the school and some of the teachers, so that they feel more confident and excited about joining 'big school'. There is no requirement to attend all sessions; your child can select as many or as few as they like. Not all choices will be guaranteed.

The sessions start at 3.30pm and last until 4.45pm, but please check timings and other requirements carefully. We are not able to offer transport, so parents have to make arrangements to get children to and from RWBA.

Unfortunately, places are limited and therefore, it would be extremely helpful if you can fill in the MSForm as soon as possible. We will then do our best to ensure every child has the opportunity to attend at least one/two sessions (this may not be their first choice).


