Dear Parents/Carers,

Junior Good Citizen Scheme – Potterne Wick Wednesday 3rd 2026

We have managed to secure a place on the Junior Good Citizen Scheme this year on the morning of Wednesday 3rd June 2026.

The Junior Good Citizen is a multi-agency event aimed at equipping young people with the life skills and knowledge to cope in an emergency or a potentially dangerous situation, which could result in them becoming victims of crime and/or sustaining personal injuries. The children interact with a number of simulated life-like scenarios during the event, which will raise their awareness of the contribution they can make in preventing crime and increasing their own safety. The emphasis is on interaction and children are encouraged to deal with a variety of safety problems making informed decisions, these include rail and road safety as well as drugs and alcohol awareness. All sessions are run by experts in each individual field and are accompanied by Noremarsch staff.

The event provides an active and stimulating opportunity to engage in learning, which relates to a variety of PSHE and Healthy Schools objectives.

The event will be run at Potterne Wick, near Devizes on Wednesday 3rd June. The children will need a packed lunch and drink (no fizzy drinks please) which we will eat upon our return and must be wearing full Noremarsch School uniform. **If you are entitled to school meals and wish to order a packed lunch, please contact the school office by the end of the month.**

We will leave school 8:30am, which means the children will need to arrive in school for no later than 8:20am.

The cost of the trip will be £12. Please log into ParentPay and pay by Wednesday 13th May. If you are unable to use ParentPay please complete the slip below and return, with contribution, to your child's class teacher by Wednesday 13th May.
